ROCKY HILL, CT – December 2nd, 2006 – The TAG2000 International LLC Holdings Company has agreed to donate web hosting, licensing, and domain name services to help this student-run non-profit conference on Asian-America and their issues. The TAG2000 International LLC Holdings Company believes in diversity and culture, and sees this conference fitting in an effort to educate others about the issues facing Asian America and the cultural gaps that must be filled.

The conference offers twenty workshops ranging from identity to advocacy, as well as a lineup of performances including two def poets, Regie Cabico and Kelly Tsai, and AZN host Taiyo Na. There will also be an open dialogue about ethnocentrism within the community to further reveal the diversity and problems the Asian-American community faces.

Headlining and keynoting the conference is Democratic new comer William Tong, who on election day, made history by becoming the first Asian-American to ever hold office in Connecticut's legislature. He is representing the 147th district of Canton and New Stafford.

In the past few years, Asian Americans living in Connecticut grew from 1.9 percent to 3.1 percent of the state's total population. The interests of this emerging community will congeal themselves into a thought provoking event on December 2nd at the University of Connecticut, Storrs. The conference organizers hope to not only address stereotypes, but rather challenge them, and in doing so unite all of Connecticut's students with a common goal: community solidarity.

IMPAACT is a Connecticut based conference devoted to strengthening and empowering the Asian American college community. Its mission is to raise awareness of issues pertaining to Asian Americans, encourage collaboration between local colleges, and to infuse leadership and inspiration to identify that missing power of Asian Americans.
